



2019 Triple Crown Sports Lodging Policy- Ronald McDonald Tournament-Week #1

Triple Crown Sports (TCS) works with a wide variety of lodging partners in our tournament locations to secure excellent lodging rates for all participants and to ensure sufficient rooms for all attending teams. Through our lodging program, all out-of-town teams book their rooms through TCS Lodging Partners and receive specially discounted rates at a variety of hotels. You can book by calling the hotel direct from the phone number listed on the TCS website.

All teams that call the hotel direct must book within the TCS Block AND submit your team hotel and ALL confirmation numbers to the report lodging link on the tournament website. Any reservations booked through a third-party provider (i.e. hotels.com, expedia, hotwire) or booked outside of the TCS room block will not fulfill requirement.

TCS Lodging policies:

To be bracketed in the RM Tournament, your team must fit into one of the following three categories:

- Stay with a Triple Crown Sports lodging partner inside of the group block (**minimum team requirement is 24 total room nights or 8 rooms for 3 nights**). Teams must submit a complete team rooming list with confirmation numbers, arrival dates and departure dates prior to event; or
- Teams playing at the Scrap Yard (Elite Division) must Stay with a Triple Crown Sports lodging partner inside of the group block (**minimum team requirement is 16 total room nights or 8 rooms for 2 nights**). Teams must submit a complete team rooming list with confirmation numbers, arrival dates and departure dates prior to event; or
- There is a buyout option. Pay a \$500.00 fee. This gives you the option to choose your own lodging. This is payable at:
- Teams within a 80-mile drive radius will request a WAIVER on the lodging policy. Please contact Jonathan at Jonathan@triplecrownsports.com. A waiver is not a document, it is a recognition from the event director that it has been approved. **This does NOT give you an option to choose your own lodging.**

Note: Teams not adhering to these policies can be removed from the event.
